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Contact Lens Evaluation/ Fitting Fees Include the following:

- Determination of the contact lenses that provide the best possible vision, comfort, and ocular health.
- Six months of follow-up care and any contact lens related doctor visits.
- Assessment of contact lens fit and visual acuity by the doctor.
- Health assessment of the front surface of the eye.
- Keratometry- which verifies the curvature of the front of the eye and screens for disease processes of the cornea.
- Any diagnostic contact lens needed to finalize contact lens prescription.
- Training with insertion and removal of contact lenses for new contact lens wearers. A refresher for previous contact lens wearers when needed.
- Training on proper care and wearing schedules for contact lenses.

In regards to our contact lens services, if you are unable to continue wearing your contact lenses or need to change the prescription of your contact lenses within a years time we will work with you to exchange any unopened boxed that you have and get you what you need.
